Since that time the sport has experienced tremendous growth and development and has evolved into the International Jump Rope Union (IJRU), the sole governing body of jump rope. IJRU represents the merged international federations of Fédération Internationale de Saut à la Corde -International Rope Skipping Federation (FISAC - IRSF) and the World Jump Rope Federation (WJRF). Combined, these two entities have produced 21 world championships. Today, IJRU enjoys Observer Status with the Alliance of Independent recognised Members of Sport (AIMS). As an AIMS Observer, IJRU is on a clear path towards the top of the Olympic family pyramid.

Our purpose is to spread the sport of jump rope / rope skipping, and with it, the joy, the physical strength, and the connectedness jumping rope provides.


Colorado College's new Ed Robson Arena is a multi-purpose, state-of-the-art, sustainable sporting event venue that benefits both the college and the City of Colorado Springs. The arena is one of four unique Colorado Springs venues designed to strengthen and diversify the economic impact of Pikes Peak region visitor attractions.

 - 3,400 permanent seats (350 student seats)

The World Championship logo series was developed to represent both the overarching championship event as well as the individual competitions including the IJRU International Open Tournament, the IJRU Junior World Jump Rope Championships, & the IJRU World Jump Rope Championships.

The combination of the summer and winter elements, from the sunny views of the springs to the snow-capped mountains, is a large part of what makes Colorado Springs so special.

The logos were developed to include these elements.

- ▲ The Sun represents the Sun Mountain in Colorado & the head of a jumper
- ▲ The Rope is derivative of the Colorado "C" on the state flag
- ▲ "IJRU" forms the snow-peaked mountains representing the Front Range of the Rockies
- ▲ The blue of the mountains connects to the summer months and springs running around Colorado Springs
